## **Brief outline of the Project**

The project will seek to:

1. Involve a wide range of people in the project – school children, trainees, unemployed, community groups, local history groups, re-enactment societies volunteers and veterans.
2. Examine the impact of conflict on local communities.
3. Enable young people to work with older generations.
4. Engage a range of community volunteers to contribute to the delivery, evaluation and sustainability of the project.
5. Investigate the impact conflict has had on local language development.

Involve groups in small restoration projects relating to warfare.

As a result of our work we will produce:

- a. An Education Pack for dissemination to local schools.
- b. A DVD by the participants of their experiences working on the project and talking to Veterans.
- c. A local Heritage trail.

A public display to maximise dissemination of the findings.
